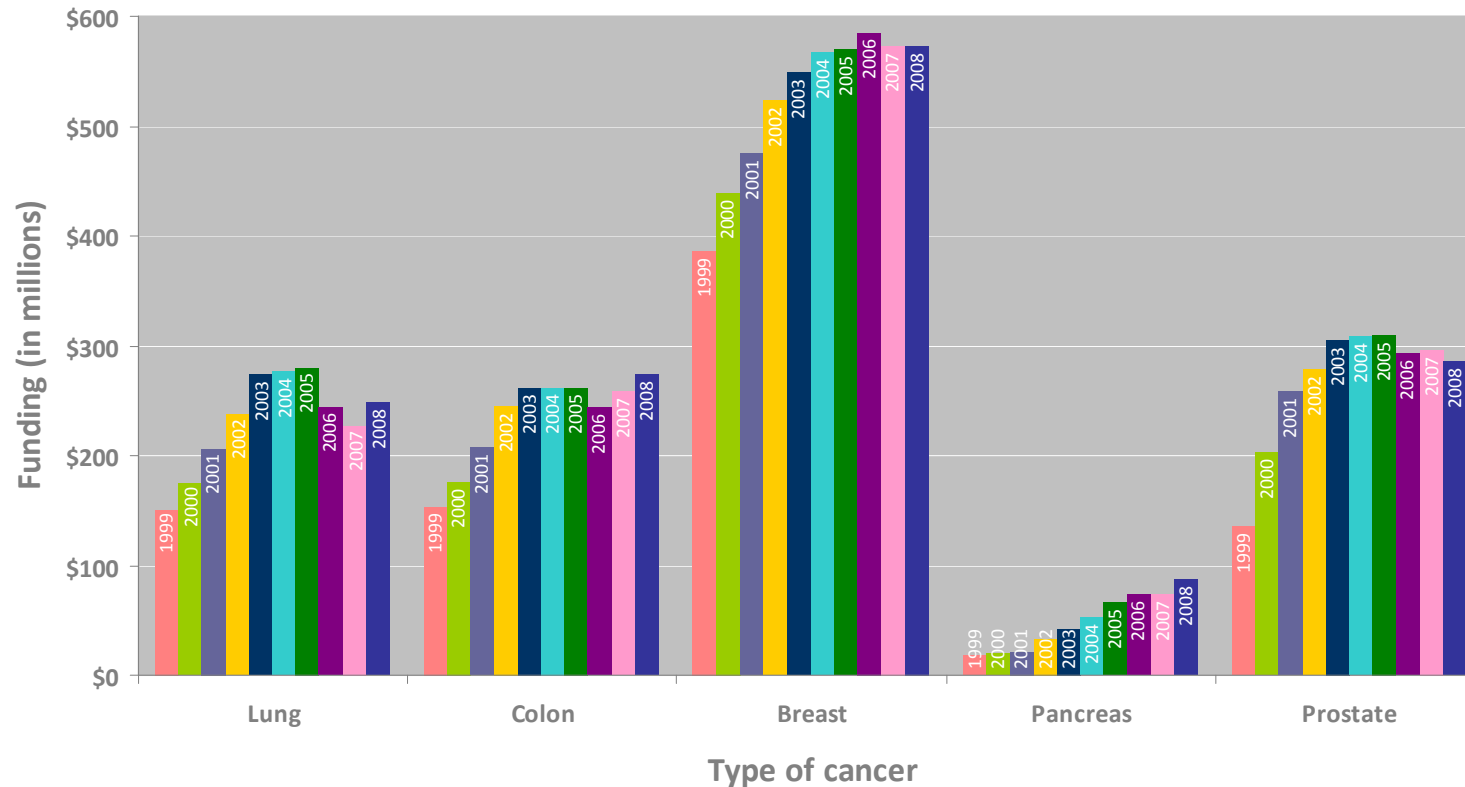




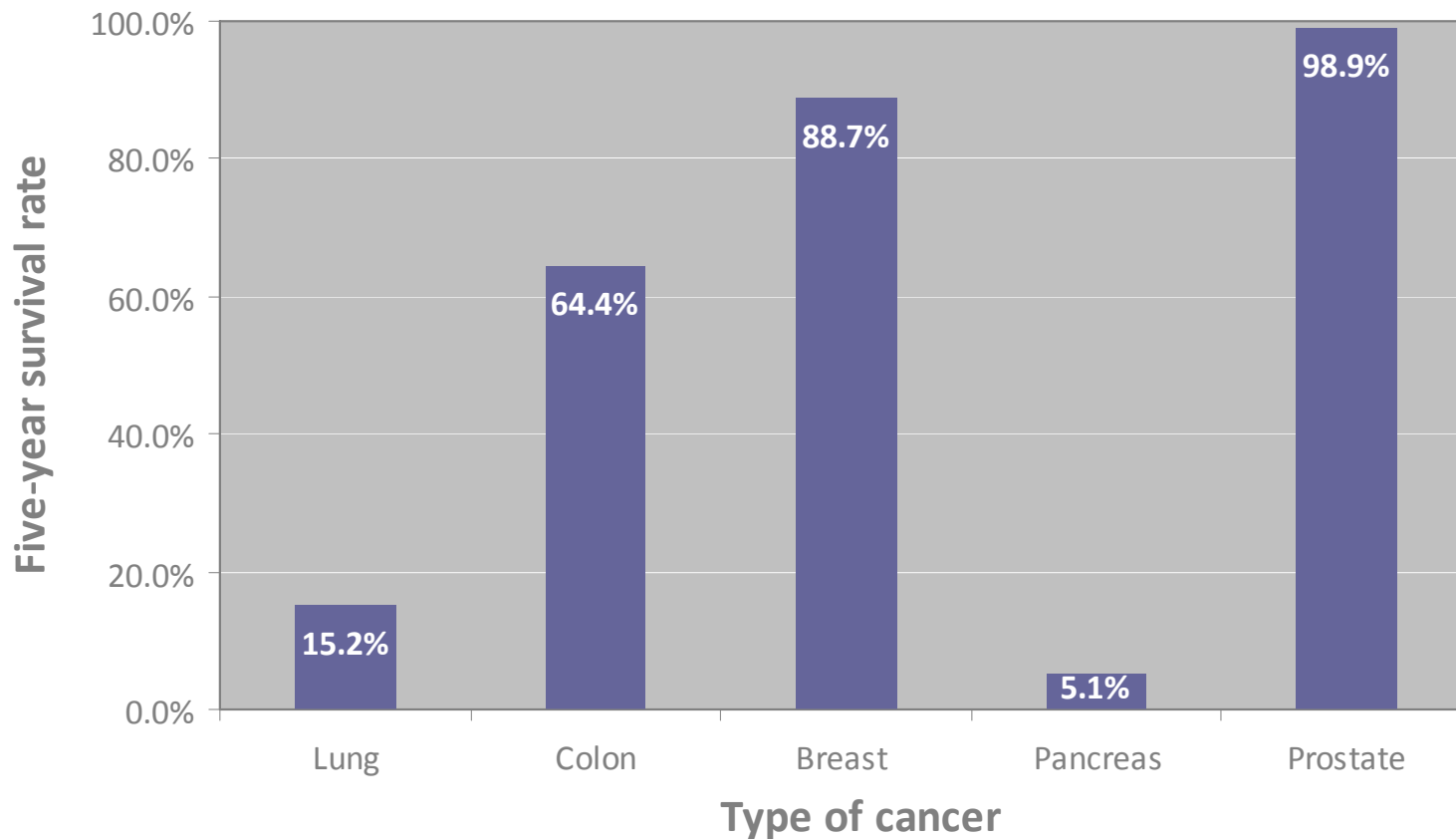
National Cancer Institute Annual Funding Top Five Causes of Cancer Death 1999-2008



Pancreatic cancer is the 4th leading cancer killer and continues to be the least funded among the top five cancer killers.



Five-Year Survival Rates Top Five Causes of Cancer Death



**Low Funding

95% of pancreatic cancer patients die within five years from their diagnosis; a statistic largely unchanged in the past 30 years. Additionally, in the same timeframe, the five year survival rate for all forms of cancer has risen from 50% to 66%, and some cancer survival rates are now close to 90% or above.
